Microchipping

A microchip is a sterile implant about the size of a grain of rice. Each microchip has an individual number which corresponds to your pet and the contact information you provide. In dogs and cats the chip is inserted beneath the skin between the shoulder blades, and does not require an anaesthetic. A microchip is identified by a special scanner which is run over the body. Veterinary surgeries, dog wardens and the RSPCA will automatically screen stray or unidentified animals.

We offer a microchipping service for all species. We use Bayer Tracer Microchips and are pleased to offer a discounted price for placing microchips at vaccination or at the same time as an operation, i.e neutering.



A simple, quick and cost effective procedure of inserting a microchip will give your pet permanent identification, which gives you peace of mind and proof of ownership of your pet. If your pet happens to get injured or lost then the likelihood of being reunited with its owner is hugely increased in microchipped animals.
